## 2010 Majors Information Sheet

The goal of the Majors program is to instruct the young player, ages 7-8, in the fundamentals of baseball in a non-competitive way. Majors is for most 1<sup>st</sup> graders who have mastered the basic skills and all 2<sup>nd</sup> graders.

**There are approximately 10 games played in the St. Michael-Albertville area. Practice and games will be played at some of the following fields in the St. Michael-Albertville area: St. Michael Elementary School, Oakside, Preserve, Highwoods, Villas, Winter Park, and Albertville Primary. Field locations are available on our web-site.**

**Practices will be on Tuesdays and Thursdays and will start on Thursday April 22<sup>nd</sup> (weather permitting). Your coach will be in touch with you no later than Wednesday, April 21<sup>st</sup> to notify you of the team your child is on and your practice site and time.**

**Games will be played on Tuesdays or Thursdays at either 6:00 or 7:15 PM. The first game is planned for Tuesday May 11<sup>th</sup> with our Annual Finale on Tuesday June 29<sup>th</sup>. Game schedules will be distributed pre-season by coaches at practice.**

Majors use a reduced injury baseball, the same size and weight of a regular baseball. The coaches pitch overhand up to 6 pitches from the mound for each at bat, then the hitter will hit off of a batting tee. Players return to the bench if the defense makes a proper out in the field. Only 10 players allowed in the field per inning. Players sitting out will be rotated and no player will sit out more than one inning a game. Every player will bat in every inning. Games are three innings or one hour long, whichever comes first. No scores or standing will be kept. Players must wear helmets when batting and base running. Catchers must wear chest and head protection. This league is designed to introduce baseball fundamentals, good sportsmanship and, overall, have fun.

**Each player will receive a T-shirt and a hat.** Pants are not provided in this league, but you may purchase them for your player. Players should have their own glove. The teams are divided randomly with an equal distribution by age. The availability and location of coaches will also be a factor on how the teams will be determined.

**Picture Day is Saturday, May 1<sup>st</sup>.** Your coach will notify you of the time. Please wear your clean uniform and hat and remember to bring a glove or bat. Pictures will be taken at Middle School West (old High School).
