2010 Sandy Koufax Information Sheet

- General Rules for Traveling and In-house -

- Players can be no older than 14 years old on April 30, 2010.
- Tryouts will be held to determine each player's abilities.
 - There is a separate TRAVELING tryout with an additional \$20 fee due at registration.
 - Based on tryout results, the players are divided between two different levels of competition
 - The AAA and AA traveling teams are selected first
 - The remaining players will play in the Quad City League (STMA, Monticello, Big Lake, and Becker)
 - In-house teams are evenly split based on tryout scores to keep the competition balanced.
- Practices will begin in mid-May or at the coach's discretion before that time. Games begin in late May. *Practices and games WILL NOT conflict with High School baseball and players are encouraged to support our school program.*
- A trained umpire will umpire all the games. Umpire rulings are final. Harassment of umpires, coaches or players will not be tolerated.
- STMA Youth Baseball will provide jerseys, pants and hats to all players.
- During the regular season players may not pitch more than 4 innings in a game.
- Game length is 7 innings. A complete game is 5 innings.
- Headed coaches are allowed to select one assistant before team selection. Additional coaches during the season are encouraged.

Traveling Information:

- Games will be played in St. Michael/Albertville and outside communities.
- Days of the week and game times will vary and will include weekend tournaments.
- Bases are 75 feet (13's) or 90 feet (14's) apart and the pitchers mound will be 52'6" (13's) or 60'6" (14's).
- This team will play a minimum of 2 weekend tournaments at an additional cost to the players.
- Additional information will be provided once the team and schedule has been determined.

In-House information:

- Games will be played in St. Michael/Albertville, Monticello, Big Lake, or Becker. Start times will be 6:00 or 6:30. Games and practices will vary depending upon game schedules and field available.
- Bases are 80 feet apart and the pitchers mound will be 55 feet from home plate.
- 9 players in the field and free substitution allowed on defense.

Picture Date (MS West – old High School): May 1st

-- Arrive at tryouts 15 minutes before your tryout time and be ready to go, GLOVE in hand. The actual tryout process will take approximately 20 minutes. --
